Nestled in the picturesque Salzkammergut of northern Austria, Schloss (Castle) Eggenberg is one of Europe's oldest breweries – built on a history dating back to the 10th century and a family heritage stretching back eight generations.

Despite a brewing range that stretches from the incredibly pure Hopfenkonig Pilsner to the off-the-charts strength of the famed Samichlaus, the brewery's beers are considered by many as some of Europe's best examples of lagering. As a result, Eggenberg is Austria's third-largest brewer and, to date, its specialty beers are exported to more than 40 countries worldwide.

## Radler Naturtrüb

Waves of bright citrus aroma beckon you closer once this liquid hits the glass. Brewed with a mix of lemon, lime and elderberry lemonade, this addition to Eggenberg's line-up might just be its most-refreshing yet – and with a history dating back to the 10th Century, that's a claim with some serious weight behind it.
